## Safety Policy Statement



4. A safe place of work along with safe access and egress.
5. A healthy working environment and adequate welfare facilities.
6. Procedures to deal with any foreseeable emergency situation.
7. Consultation with employees in the aims and achievements of the policy statement objectives.

The company will encourage a general interest in health and safety away from the workplace and promote, where practical, ideas and suggestions from all parties as to how this may be achieved.
